



Marvin D. Miller (April 23, 1934 – April 24, 2017)

Our dear friend, colleague, and founding member, Marv Miller, died on April 24 in Clarks Summit, PA, where he was born and raised, the 6th generation of Millers that farmed there.

Marv loved everything outdoors, and was an avid hunter and trapper all his life. After graduating from Penn State Forestry School in 1955, he had a long career as a wood products engineer with Koppers, Inc. He was also active in the Civil Air Patrol and the Lookout Fire Department near Golden, CO.

Marv was a founding member and many-term officer of the Colorado Trappers Association. He won many ribbons for marksmanship and the liars contest at the annual Rendezvous.
